Appointments

Please be mindful that appointments are for 10 minutes only. The GP will deal with your main problem, however it is not always possible to deal with multiple issues and may ask you to book a further appointment.

Medicines Monitoring

If you are on a medication that requires regular monitoring, your clinician will have discussed this with and you may be sent an sms to prompt you to book for a blood test. These can be booked at the Practice on Tuesdays and Fridays. Failure to have these regular blood tests may mean that your repeat prescription request is delayed.

NEWS FROM THE PATIENT PARTICIPATION GROUP (PPG)

Patient Participation Groups (PPGs) work together with GP surgeries to promote health awareness and improve services and quality of care.

PPGs are an opportunity for interested patients to be involved in supporting their GP surgery. At Old Court House (OCH) we help to keep patients informed of changes to services via our Newsletters and Patient Leaflets.

Access to medical services

Access to the surgery is now easier and there is no longer a request to 'phone back tomorrow.' Patients can also request a 'call back.' Please only call at 8.00am for urgent appointments and if needing to speak to Reception about a routine appointment call later when the lines are less busy.

Routine appointments and general requests can be made through the OCH website - click on the online contact form.

Patients can book GP appointments via the NHS App. Both telephone and in person appointments are available. Remember not everything needs to be dealt with by a doctor.

While promoting the efficiency of digital communication, the surgery has made provision for those patients without access to a computer, tablet or mobile phone. If patients are unable to use online services, they can continue to telephone or call in at Reception for appointments.

The NHS App

The NHS App is safe and secure. If you're aged 16 and over, you can register for the NHS App without visiting the Practice. It is a simple and secure way to access a range of services on your smartphone or tablet and is free from app stores. The NHS App is also available on the OCH website.

It can be used to conveniently:

- book and cancel appointments.
- order repeat medication.
- view your health record including consultations, diagnosis, documents and results of tests or investigations.
- view your Covid vaccination status.
- check your symptoms using reliable NHS information on hundreds of conditions and treatments.
- register to be an organ donor.
- choose how the NHS uses your data.
